### **National Child Cancer Network Governance Group**

We are seeking expressions of interest from interested and suitably qualified people to become members of the Governance Group for the National Child Cancer Network.

#### **About the National Child Cancer Network**

The National Child Cancer Network (NCCN) provides clinical leadership and national oversight of the delivery of child cancer services in New Zealand.

#### **About the Governance Group**

The Governance Group will determine and oversee the NCCN strategic direction, strategic priorities, and programme of work. The Governance Group will ensure Te Tiriti o Waitangi is prioritised throughout and across the NCCN programme of work and ensure equity of health outcomes, appropriate access to services, and experience of care is a priority across the work of the Network.

The Governance Group will include the NCCN Executive Management Team and a Te Aho o Te Kahu representative. In addition, we are looking for a diverse membership that will include representation of the voices of Māori, and Pacific peoples, as well as registered (or ex-registered) health professionals.

#### **Who are we looking for?**

We are seeking expressions of interest from suitably qualified people who have an interest in child cancer and have experience in governance roles.

We are specifically seeking those with Māori or Pacific backgrounds, in addition to those who are registered (or ex-registered) health professionals.

A member may be appointed who fulfils more than one role or representation from the above list. Where possible a balance will be sought in appointing members from across Aotearoa, New Zealand.

#### **What is the commitment if I am appointed as a member of the Governance Group?**

The Group will meet a minimum of 3 times a year, with one in-person meeting per year. Meetings being up to 90 minutes duration. There will be pre-reading ahead of the meetings. Membership will be reviewed every 3-years.
